

Venturing Crew 2052

Code of Conduct

As adopted August 20, 2003

1. No sex, period on Scout outings.
2. No cussing or profane language.
3. No drugs, alcohol, or weapons at any scout function.
4. No "one-on-ones".
5. No PDA (Public Display of Affection). PDA is defined by crew 2052 as no one-on-one massages, holding hands, "long hugs", and kissing. (Greeting hugs are okay). Remember this is not a dating atmosphere.
6. No malicious gossip or rumors, or any actions which might be taken as hazing or some type of exclusion of any member.
7. No girls going into guys cabins or tents and no guys in girls cabins or tents.
8. Wear appropriate clothing. If you don't, and someone asks you to change your clothes; you need to or you will be asked to leave the event.
9. No inappropriate behavior or actions, remember as we are girls in a predominately male organization, our every move will be scrutinized.

Offense of any item above, at an event, the adult in charge may decide if the Crew Member needs to be dismissed and sent home from the event, by way of their parent and at their expense. Any offense of Item #3 will result in immediate expulsion from the Crew and the Boy Scouts of America.
